



2019 LACUE Awards

The Louisiana Association of Computer Using Educators recognizes educators who have effectively integrated the use of technology into the educational process. Each nominee should be someone who is using technology in an innovative fashion. The awards program is open to all educators associated with private, public, and parochial schools located within the state of Louisiana. Nominations are being accepted from teachers, students, administrators, parents, etc.

Note: Winners from 2016, 2017 and 2018 are not eligible

Outstanding professionals can be nominated in the following categories:

1. Elementary Teacher of the Year (Grades PreK-5)
2. Middle/Junior High Teacher of the Year (Grades 6-8)
3. Secondary Teacher of the Year (Grades 9-12)

Personnel such as librarians and technology lab teachers, should be nominated in grade level categories.

4. Post-Secondary Teacher of the Year
5. Leader of the Year (Certified non-classroom personnel)

Nominees for the leader category include non-classroom personnel such as district-level personnel, principals, and assistant principals.

Two Ways to Make a Nomination (PICK ONE):

Option 1: Submit a Complete Nomination Form

Use this option if you are nominating an individual and can answer all of the questions on the nomination form (including work experience, involvement in professional organizations, presentations at professional conferences, and how the individual promotes and supports the use of technology into the school/classroom).

Option 2: Submit a Partial Nomination Form

Use this option if you cannot complete all of the questions on the nomination form, but would still like to nominate a deserving individual. LACUE will contact your nominee and direct him/her to the nomination form. NOTE: The nominee will NOT enter the regional competition until a complete nomination form has been submitted. Your name will be included in the notification as the person making the nomination.

Regional winners will be selected in each category and will be announced no later than November 1, 2019. A state award winner will be named from each category at the opening session of the Annual LACUE Conference, December 10-12, 2019.

Regional winners will receive FREE REGISTRATION to the annual conference!
